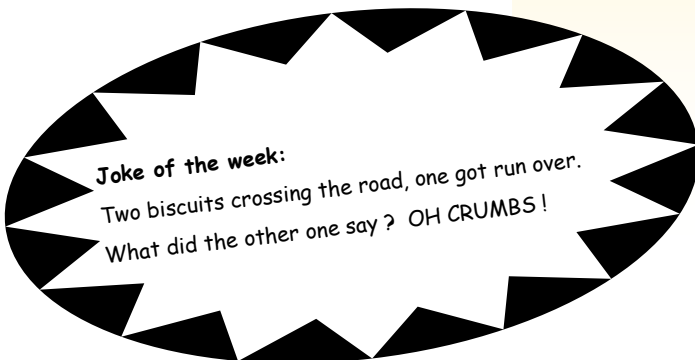

Payments for dinners should be made on a Monday and sent into school in a sealed named envelope.

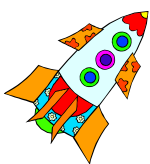
Uniform

Old logo uniform is available from the office however we only have a very limited amount of stock.

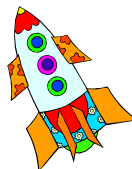
