Cheques should be made payable to:

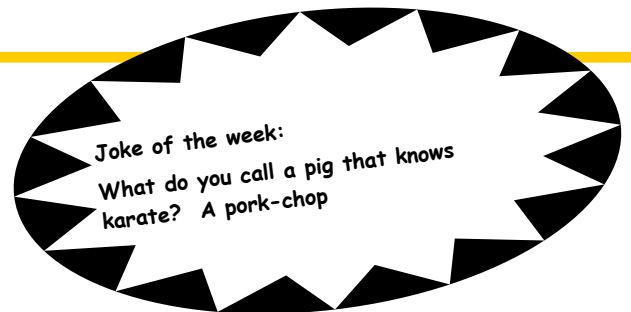

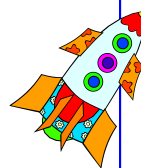
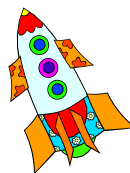
