Appointments during School time

It has become apparent that many pupils are having dental and medical appointments arranged during the school day. Although we understand that appointments cannot always be arranged after school, it would be appreciated if routine dental appointments and non-urgent doctor's appointments could be made at the end of the school day or during school holidays.

Obviously, hospital and orthodontic appointments cannot always be negotiated and we do understand this. However, a note or copy of the appointment card is required prior to the appointment date. Notification of all appointments should be given to the office at least 48 hours in advance and this will be entered on the electronic registration system and marked accordingly.

Online safety at Christmas

This year, computer games which can be played on line, will be at the top of many Christmas wish lists.

Please consider the following before letting children play online at home.

Do some homework about the game.

Check what age group they are suitable for and whether the game has violence, explicit language and anti social behaviour within it.



Or an adult theme.

Be aware of cyber bullies.

Set a time limit to play the game.

Make sure your child uses a suitable screen or character name. Make sure it doesn't reveal any personal information.

Remind children to:

Be extra careful not to give out personal information to people they don't know or to enter their full name, address, email, telephone number and any key password information on un-trusted websites.

If you feel the online contact is inappropriate report to CEOP.

Try and be more vigilant when accepting emails, opening files or using un-trusted web pages, which contain the following: viruses, spam, scams and inappropriate messages.

Be wary about trusting someone online. They can be lying about who they are, what they have or what they can give. Information online/internet is not always reliable.

Make sure they make someone aware if they have witnessed inappropriate content or someone has made them feel uncomfortable. Children and young people should inform their parents, carers or group leader. If you feel more serious action is needed contact CEOP.

Check that children and young people are aware of how to report offenders, block and mute messages.

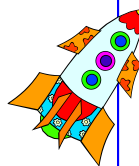
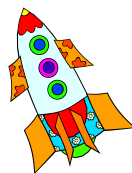
