The cost of dinner per day is £1.90, £9.50 a week.

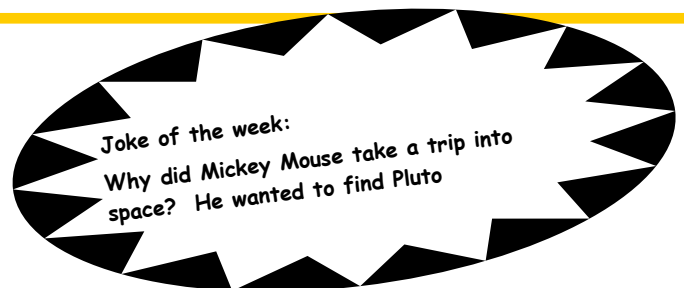
Cheques should be made payable to:

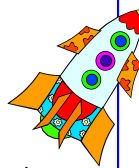
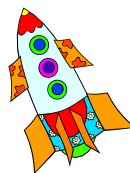
