Salt and Vinegar Tempura Fish Fillet and Chips

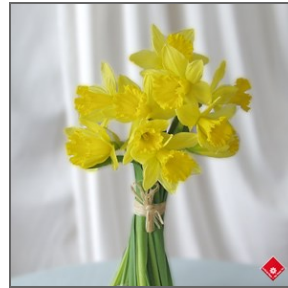
Vegetarian Option is Quorn Sausage and chips

Safe Guarding—Stranger Danger.

Whilst most people are friendly and genuine, there are some who mean harm to children.

The following advice is available for children from Warwickshire Police. A stranger is someone they haven't met before. You can't tell if a person you do not know is good or bad, even if they look and seem nice.

Always...

- Say NO to a stranger, stay away from strangers
- Play with your friends and when playing away from home,
- Look after your younger brothers and sisters and friends
- Tell your parents, or a responsible adult that you know, where you are going, who you are going with and what time you will be back
- Return home by the agreed time
- Tell your parents, teacher, police officer or responsible adult that you know if you approached by a stranger
- Go home as quickly as you can if a stranger comes up to you. If you can't get home, go somewhere you know will be safe, like your school or a police station

Never...

- Walk off with a stranger,
- Go near or get into a strange car or van, whatever the stranger says
- Take sweets or presents, even if it is something you really want

The cost of dinner per day is £1.90, £9.50 a week.

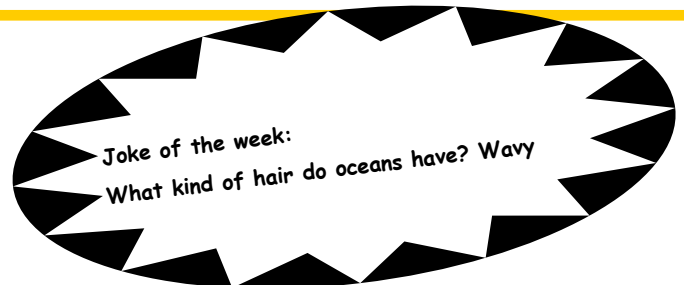
Cheques should be made payable to:
