



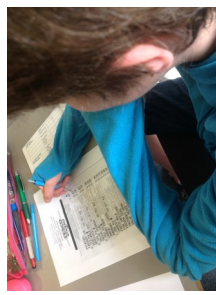
# The Heads Up



## Magical Maths

On Monday and Tuesday the whole school took part in a two day maths event. Early Years and Key Stage 1 read a book called '365 Penguins'. They used this book to work through a range of mathematical challenges including - The quickest way to get to the iceberg, How many penguins would turn up in a month and How they could fit the penguins together.

Key Stage 2 worked with Tesco's Community Champion to make their very own lemonade. Working out the ratio of sugar to lemon juice to create the ultimate lemonade. The children then worked out a shopping list where they had a £10 budget of which they had to make a net profit. The cost of dinner per day is £1.90, £9.50 a week.

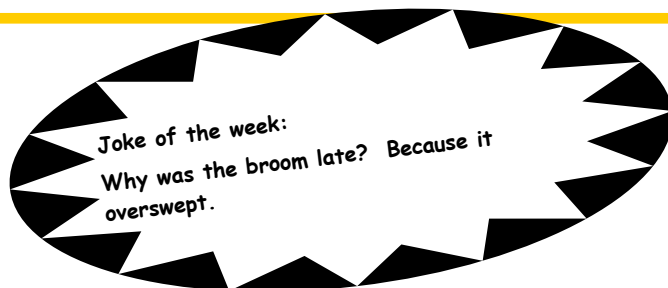

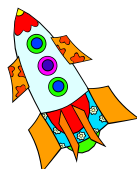
