Whole School Focus: Looking for Learning

Making Maths Vivid

Subjects

• Literacy:

We will be looking at writing and reading debates using both formal and informal language. Our first debate will centre on whether or not CCTV should be allowed in classrooms!

We will use our theme of fairgrounds, to write some poetry using the sounds, shapes and speeds as ideas.

Story writing will come from the idea of an adventure at the fairground, where something happens or someone goes missing.

The children will also be looking at our VCOP display to help them with their exciting writing.

Remember that V - Vocabulary, C - Connectives, O - openers (for sentences) P - Punctuation.

Numeracy

- 3D shapes
- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication
- Division
- Fractions/ decimals / percentages
- Real life word problems
- Place value (multiplying by 10, 100)

Art/ DT - the children will be looking at designing and making their very own fairground rides. They will investigate the different movements, then look to make a model either on their own or in small groups.

PHSE: reaching for the stars and changes.

PE The children will be looking at athletics and tennis during the first term, then move onto dance linked with the Fairgrounds.

Music: Exploring musical processes - We will look at different starting points, processes and structures which composers might use to create music. We will develop our own pieces of music using what we have learnt about these procedures.

How to Help Your Child

- We ask you to support your child by hearing them read their individual levelled reading books at home. We would appreciate it if parents could sign and make a comment in the reading diaries every week. Helpers may also hear your child read their individual reading book in school, so it is important that this book is brought to school **every day**.

Please ensure your child has:-

- A PE kit (**named** pumps or trainers, white T-shirt, navy blue or black shorts, jogging bottoms and sweatshirt (during winter months) in **named** bag) must be in school every day and kept on children's pegs. It is recommended that they are taken home for washing every half term.
- A **named** water bottle containing water only.
- A blue sweater for when we go out on trips.
