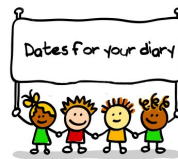

Look out for Club sign up sheet as soon as we come back to school.

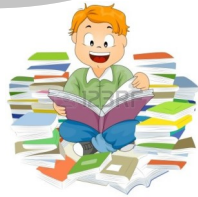
