# Purple4Polio

The Rotary Club of Leamington Spa Regency has given our school 500 crocus corms to plant as part of the **Purple4Polio** campaign. Eradicating polio has been the Rotary Club's main humanitarian focus for 30 years. The amount of polio-endemic countries has dropped from 125 to just three, with over 2.5 billion children receiving vaccinations thanks to the help of Rotary. The purple flowers represent the purple dye used to mark the finger of a child to indicate that they have received their life saving oral vaccine. They are aiming to plant 10 million purple crocus corms in 2017 and our green fingered children at Clapham Terrace will be helping them to achieve their goal. Thank you to the Rotary Club!
