



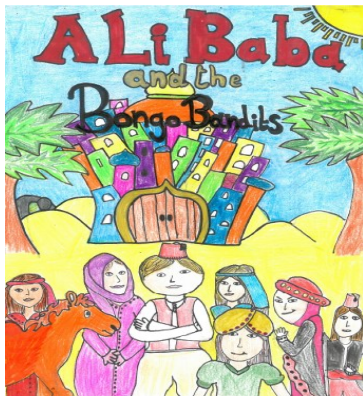
# Heads Up

We hope you have the chance to read the report as it really does showcase our school and community.

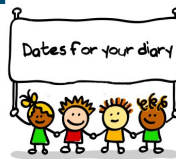

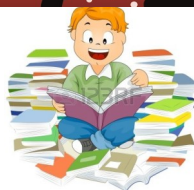

## Snap Chat—Change to Location Feature

We are aware that some of our pupils use Snap Chat. This is not something we would advise at all but the reality is that some of our older children are exposed to it. We would like to draw to your attention the fact that the app has launched a new update called 'Snap Map' which allows users to share their location in real time, using the smartphone's GPS sensor.

Given how the specific the feature is we would like to make you aware of this change as the default setting will be for users' location to be visible to other users. Whilst it may be useful for locating a genuine friend, this feature does allow people's exact location to be potentially tracked by a strangers.

We have had no information that this feature has been used maliciously but would urge you to disable any feature in order to safeguard your child. To disable this feature you should go to "ghost mode" in their Snap Chat app. Simply pinch the screen (as if zooming out from a photo) when it is in the selfie mode, to bring up the Snap Map. We hope this information is useful.
