Congratulations to Years 6 on what were outstanding SATs scores:

96% Reading, 96% SPaG

93% Writing and 93% Maths

It's looking like we will have between 40-50% of children who have performed at the higher level, but this is yet to be confirmed.

Our Key Stage 1 scores are also well above national, with 80% achieving the standard in Reading, Writing and Maths and a third of the children at the higher level.

Year 1 Phonics was 90% and our Reception achieved 77% GLD.
