What are Year 6 up to?

Year 6 are studying Animals and Their Habitats. They've explored classification using the Linnaean method made by Carl Linnaeus and are now studying microorganisms, with fungi being the main focus.

They began by learning how microorganisms can help us, for instance in helping bread rise and making wine, using yeast in both cases. They also looked at harmful viruses like chicken pox and flu.

They planned an investigation exploring in which conditions a slice of bread grows mould the quickest and whether the opposite condition makes any difference.
