Key vocabulary	
Equator	An imaginary line drawn on the Earth and spaced equally between the North and South Pole
Latitude	Imaginary horizontal lines that circle the Earth parallel to the equator
Longitude	Imaginary vertical lines that stretch from the North Pole to the South Pole
Northern Hemisphere	The half of the Earth that is north of the equator
Southern Hemisphere	The half of the Earth that is south of the equator
Tropics	The area between the Tropic of Cancer and the Tropic of Capricorn
Arctic Circle	An imaginary line drawn around the northern part of the world at approximately 66° North
Antarctic Circle	An imaginary line drawn around the southern part of the world at approximately 66° South
