SATs final results

Congratulations to Year 6 on what were outstanding SATs scores: 74% Reading (with 33% Greater Depth), 85% SPaG (with 48% GD), 81% Writing (with 33% GD), and 78% Maths (with 48% GD).

Our Key Stage 1 scores are also well above national, with 83% achieving the standard in Reading, Writing and Maths and a third of the children at the higher level. Year 1 Phonics was 90% and our Reception achieved 72% GLD.

All our scores are well above national once again and significantly above at Greater Depth.
