Geography: Statement of Intent

It is our intent at Clapham Terrace Primary that the children receive a high quality geography curriculum which inspires curiosity and fascination about the world and its people in them.

At Clapham Terrace we believe that geography helps to provoke and provide answers to questions about the natural and human aspects of the world. Children are encouraged to develop a greater understanding and knowledge of the world, as well as their place in it. The geography curriculum at Clapham Terrace enables children to develop knowledge and skills that are progressive, as well as transferable, throughout their time at Clapham Terrace Primary and also to their further education and beyond.

From EYFS through to year 6 the children develop a sense of their community, through local area walks and educational visits. The children are continually furthering their knowledge about the wider world, supported by the use maps, globes, atlases and ICT in their work. They have many opportunities to create their own maps and conduct surveys, which further their learning. The school grounds and Leamington town centre are used for practical field—work, exploring human and physical features.

It is our intention that all children develop of real sense of who they are, their heritage and what makes our local area unique and special. We encourage children to share their learning at home to develop their geographical vocabulary and knowledge, this is supported through our knowledge organisers, which are given to parents before the start of each new topic.
