Key vocabulary	
Drought	When an area gets less than its normal amount of rain, over months or even years
Foggy	Fog is like a cloud, but it is near the ground, not high in the sky. Thick fog makes it difficult to see
Globe	A spherical model of Earth
Hail	Water that gets caught in strong upward moving winds. The water will freeze, then start to fall,
Seasons	The seasons are four different times during the year with different types of weather. They are spring, summer, autumn and winter, and are caused by the earth's orbit around the sun, its rotation on its axis, and its tilt.
Storms	A heavy period of rain, snow, wind or hail
Tides	The rise and fall of sea levels around the world
Tropical	Places near the equator, it is warm to hot and moist year-round.
World	The earth and all that are on it
