Phonics

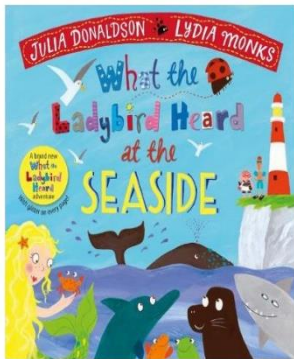
