## **Early Years Outdoor Area**





We thought you may like to see the Outdoor Area. Your child will use this daily to access the equipment and resources.

### Here are the Indoors Areas that your child will have access to.

At Clapham Terrace, we are an Early Years
Unit, so we often collaborate with the
Reception children. We learn through joint
topics and share all areas and resources.

The Nursery classroom is where the children spend time in the morning.
Registration is taken here, as well as a short, daily Phonics and Maths sessions.

## **Indoor Areas**









#### We will teach your child to access these areas independently





The children will have responsibility for their own water bottles and snacks. Your child must bring a water bottle each day and may bring a healthy snack but this is optional as we do provide fruit. Please be aware we are a nut free school.

Each child will have a named coat peg. We request each child bring in a named bag of spare clothes to remain in Nursery.

The children will be encouraged to use the toilets regularly and washing hands takes place frequently throughout the day.

Each child will have their own tray in which their Reading Folder goes.





#### Clapham Terrace 'Houses'



At Clapham Terrace we have four Houses, Dragon, Unicorn, Phoenix and Goblin. Your child will be allocated a House.

The children will be given a Reading Folder, the colour will match that of their House. These folders must come into the Nursery each morning. Please check these daily; school letters for you are put inside these folders. School policy is that you read with your child three times a week, however in Early Years we request you share reading with your child daily. Please record all shared reading in the yellow Reading Diary, we will do the same as we read with your child. This diary can be used as a two way communication between home and school.
