Thank you for your co-operation.

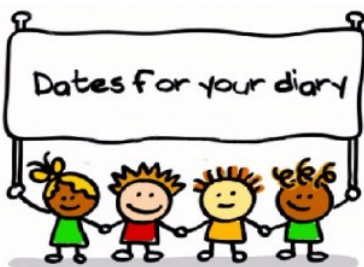

COMMUNICATION VIA THE **TEACHERS2PARENTS** and **SCHOOLMONEY APP**

Can we remind all parents that, whilst we recommend that you download the **teachers2parents** app for easy access to communications, **schoolmoney** payments and history, please be aware that **if you have the app you will no longer receive text messages through your normal text system, instead these will appear on your app.**

It is therefore important that you have your notifications turned on for the app to ensure you are notified of messages coming through. To do this go to your settings, notifications and select teachers2parents, allow notifications.

Please note that if you have the app installed on a device other than your phone you will not receive text messages on your phone - we therefore suggest that you do not download the app on to devices other than your phone and instead access **schoolmoney** via the website.

If you have any questions please contact the school office who will be happy to help. However, please be aware that we are unable to change this and cannot enable you to receive messages via the app **and** via normal text messages.
