The past academic year has seen an increased number of children from across the Key Stages participating in a range of sports competition against other schools. A number of our KS2 children on the Special Educational Needs register have also had the opportunity to take part in sports competitions. The success of many of our children in these competitions has further raised the profile of sport in the school.

The decision to hold our whole school Sports Day during a morning proved to be a great success and we have plans to develop and expand the scope of opportunities for the children for next year.



Our teams' successes in the Central Area School Games competitions again resulted in 13 of our children representing the Central Area at the School Games County Finals. We were also invited to take a team to participate in an inclusive tennis competition.

Our commitment to, and participation in the local schools' competitions has been acknowledged and applauded by the School Sports Partnership competition organisers.



Over the next year, we aim to develop our intra-school sport, giving all of our children the opportunity to participate in competitive sport through our revamped House system. Winners at this level will be those who go on to represent the school at the Level 2 competitions.
